He deemed it necessary to recall "certain fundamental truths of Catholic
doctrine, which ... risk being distorted or denied" in the field of moral theology.*

To acknowledge and celebrate its twenty-fifth anniversary, the University of Notre Dame-Australia, will sponsor a multi-disciplinary Symposium on the legacy of this encyclical.

Speakers have been invited to present 30-40 minute papers on the theme. In round-table discussion, fellow presenters will then respond to the paper. Collegial dialogue will be an opportunity to consider St John Paul II's contribution and influence to the *status questionis* of moral theology and philosophy in the post-Conciliar Church.
